Boulder Carriage House Community Table provides a safe, supportive place for the homeless and working poor. Many have lost their homes, jobs, families and the courage to dream of a better life. The Carriage House wants to give them hope again along with the opportunity for free meals, medical and mental health services, and the chance to meet with a case worker who can help with anything from employment to addiction concerns. In 2008 they served over 2500 people and helped over 100 find jobs. They also offer the chance for people to volunteer and help support those who are in need in their community. More than 335 people gave over 33,000 hours of their time.
